
DEVOTIONAL

Inventors take ordinary objects and transform them into extraordinary innovations with some creativity and a lot of tinkering. WEEK 1 Jesus is one of a kind. Luke 2:41–52; John 1:10–14



STUDY

Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



PRAY

Pray and ask for the wisdom to follow Jesus' example and share his love with those around you.



GROW

So what's your next step? How can you make space in your life to know Jesus better? In what ways can you reflect Jesus' unique love in your daily interactions? Who in your life needs to hear about the one-of-a-kind hope Jesus offers? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.

WEEK 2 Jesus is humble. Matthew 3:13-17; Philippians 2:5-11



STUDY

Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



PRAY

Pray for the strength to put others before yourself, and to serve with



GROW

So what's your next step? Where in your life is God inviting you to practice humility? Are there times when pride or the desire for recognition gets in the way of serving others? How can you shift your mindset to reflect the humility of Jesus? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.

WEEK 3 Jesus trusted God. Luke 4:1–13; Psalm 40:1–4



Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



PRAY

Pray for the strength to follow God's way when you're tempted to go a different direction.



GROW

So what's your next step? How can Jesus' example in the wilderness encourage you when you're facing struggles or temptations? How can you practice using God's words in situations where you feel tempted to make a poor choice. What would it look like to wait on God with confidence, knowing that God's plans are good?

WEEK 4 Jesus calls us to follow.

Matthew 4:13–23; Ephesians 5:1–2



STUDY

Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



PRAY

Pray and ask God to help you recognize the ways Jesus is calling you to follow.



GROW

So what's your next step? What does following Jesus look like in your daily life? Is there something specific God is calling you to do right now? Who can you invite to walk beside you as you follow Jesus together? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.
